



APPLYING FOR TEAM GAMING LICENCE

Teams apply for Class D Licences.

The first page of the online application asks you to search to determine whether your organization exists in the system. Since there are new teams each year, your team WILL NOT exist.

Search in this manner: 2015/16 Ridge Meadows Minor Hockey Bantam C1

Since your team will not exist, it will then give you a button called "New Applicant" - press that button and then proceed to enter your information for your team only.

Again, the "organization name" you enter is your team (i.e. 2015/16 Ridge Meadows Minor Hockey Bantam C1)

You do not have an incorporation number and you do not have a charitable number. You can ignore those parts of the application.

Failure to follow these instructions and applying for a licence under the Association name is strictly forbidden. Paragraph 6.4 of our Policy Manual states:

"6.4 Gaming Licenses: Teams must apply for a gaming license using their individual team name and season (ie. 2014-15 Ridge Meadows Peewee C2 Rustlers). Teams shall NOT apply under the name Ridge Meadows Minor Hockey Association. Any team found to have done so will be subject to a \$500 fine payable to RMMHA, along with a potential referral to the discipline committee. Each team must supply a copy of their approved gaming license to the Division Manager prior to sales for the event."
