## QUORUM

- 1. Motion to approve minutes from July 6, 2015 Nolan. Seconded by Derek G. Carried
- 2. Sportsmanship Starts in the Stands Program Carolyn shared information she received from BC Hockey regarding this program and their expectations in holding a meeting. Peter suggests that we provide the information at the 'A' Parent Meeting for sure and then we need to determine how many other meetings we want to hold for parents to attend. Scott pointed out that this is in conjunction with our policies and discipline over unacceptable behaviour. Decision made that we will hold an evening meeting on Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup> and a morning and an afternoon option on Sunday, October 4.

There is one more goalie that just moved to Pitt Meadows from Coquitlam but we haven't received the transfer paperwork yet. Summer Registration reminder emails will be going out to try to fill the sessions.
