		There is discussion that the team official exemption may be pulled. Can we look at how we can support the teams who may be impacted by this change?
		In the last two weeks we've had one notification from Fraser Health for one U11C team for self-monitoring due to possible exposure.
		We added the self-assessment tool on to the website at the advice of a Fraser health nurse (parent).
