Good opportunity for volunteers?

We need to communicate to division managers how jersey return will go and how the name bars will be taken off jerseys.

We will charge \$10 per player (\$5 per jersey) to remove name bars.

Teams need to take the jerseys to Bill's to have name bars removed. The teams will pay for the service at Bill's.

Name bars stay with parents, jerseys come back to the association.

We need to get this information out to the division managers to pass along to the team managers.- Sarah and Brad will put together something to send out. Nick will put a call out for volunteers for jersey return – they will receive jerseys, check the list to make sure all jerseys are there and in good shape.

We will have different days for different divisions (A will return to Pitt). Peter will arrange a day for goalie equipment return.

Board members will help out and oversee jersey return.

Next year can we get Aaron at Bill's to charge the fee for putting on and taking off name bars at the same time. (at the beginning of the season)
