**Maple Ridge** is a vibrant city nestled between the **Golden Ears mountains and the Fraser River**, known for its scenic landscapes, friendly atmosphere, and mix of urban and rural charm. It offers a range of shopping, cultural venues, festivals, and outdoor spaces.

### OUR FIRST NATIONS HISTORY:

#### **First Nations History of Maple Ridge & Pitt Meadows (Summary)**

The lands now known as **Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows** lie within the **traditional, ancestral, and unceded territory of the Katzie First Nation,**

part of the Coast Salish peoples. These lands have been inhabited for **thousands of years**—long before European contact.

### **Katzie First Nation**

The **Katzie people** lived throughout the lower Fraser River, Pitt River, and surrounding marshlands, forests, and mountains. Their name comes from the Halkomelem word *q'ic'ay'*, meaning “**land of moss.**” The environment supported a rich and sustainable way of life based on fishing, hunting, gathering, and trade.

Today, the **Katzie First Nation** remains an active and vital community, working to preserve language, culture, and traditions while participating in environmental stewardship and local governance. Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows continue to acknowledge that they are on **unceded Katzie territory**, recognizing the ongoing presence and rights of the First Nations people of this land.
