Season Start:

Evaluations:

- Began in early September
- U11C and U13C evaluated by coaches through skills skates and game play
- U15C and U18C evaluated by RMMHA development team in game play only
- 7 U11C, 6 U13C, 6 U15C and 7 U18C teams

Team formation:

- Evaluation data was averaged for each C athlete and then ranked
- Coaches agreed on player ranking and then chose athletes in a snake draft format
- Exception this season was in U18C where coaches disagreed with the numbers presented by Development team

In Season:

Balancing, league structure + playoffs:

- Teams moved to balancing early October
- Minimal player movement occurred
- A note for future seasons - teams are not final until we are satisfied that teams are balanced
 - This decision is not easy and is not up for appeal
 - More than one player may be moved from one team to satisfy balancing.
- New PCAHA league structure
- PCAHA playoff structure (back to tiering)

Challenges:

- Goalies
 - Continues to be feast or famine
- Development
 - Lead Developer concept was successfully delivered in U11C and U13C, and all U18C teams saw the lead developer at least once
 - U15C saw a huge gap in development until Jordan O'Farrell took over in February
- Behaviour
 - Let the refs ref
 - Zero tolerance for physical altercations and verbal abuse.
 - Be respectful of volunteers - don't cross the line!

- Team Managers as a whole very responsive and did a great job of working with Ice Allocator to reschedule conflict games and work around practice conflicts
 - Scheduling of the Winter Round Up and Jim Lindsay tournaments over the Christmas break allowed for more ice to be available for playoff games, Rustler Cup, and teams to continue to practice until the end of the year. Also meant we didn't have to buy extra ice in the last month

General Operations

- Increased Summer Development opportunities.
- Try goalie week was another success.
- Continued to evaluate and improve the evaluation process used for both 'A', 'C' and 'H' (TeamGenius). Still evolving year over year.
- Revamped our Training Camp Appeal process
- Participated and Lead PCAHA and BC Hockey working groups to help improve the game we love. U11A Playoff format, U11-18C Team Formation Model.
- Worked with VP Admin and Treasurer to manage the change in operating budget due to rising costs.
- We ran 4 tournaments this year successfully!
- Advocated to Maple Ridge City Councillors regarding facilities and the need for new facilities.
- Rustler Golf Classic was another success and great experience for sponsors, golfers, and volunteers.

Development Program

- Collaborated with VP-A/VP-C to improve the goalie development program - very successful - high demand. Working towards other scheduling options

SPECIAL RESOLUTION: To Amend Bylaw 5.10(e) – Board Member Attendance Requirement - Nick - second - Angela - carried

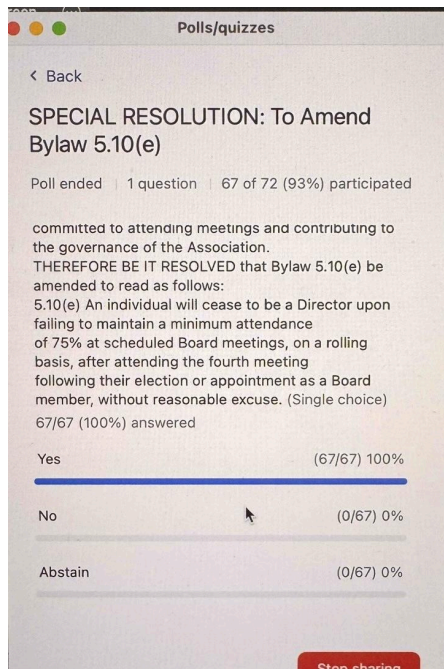
Current Wording:

5.10(e) An individual will cease to be a Director upon being absent without reasonable excuse from three (3) successive meetings of the Board in a Membership Year.

WHEREAS the Ridge Meadows Minor Hockey Association (RMMHA) Board is a working board that relies on the active participation of all directors. The Board cannot operate effectively without consistent attendance from its members. This amendment ensures that directors remain committed to attending meetings and contributing to the governance of the Association.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Bylaw 5.10(e) be amended to read as follows:

5.10(e) An individual will cease to be a Director upon failing to maintain a minimum attendance of 75% at scheduled Board meetings, on a rolling basis, after attending the fourth meeting following their election or appointment as a Board member, without reasonable excuse.
