Want to Find Your Previous Certifications:	How to Check On Your Previous Certifications (via Spordle) NEW IN 2021-22: Team officials (Managers, Coaches, & HCSP) must create a Spordle account in order to view their certifications. 1. Create/login to a Spordle Account https://account.spordle.com/login 2. Go to the Members tab, and click the icon that looks like a person with a + on their head. 3. Enter your name and birthdate OR your HCR number, click search. 4. When you find yourself, click "link member". 5. You will now be able to see your HCR profile in the dashboard under "my members". 6. Click on your HCR profile. 7. Go to the Qualifications tab to see all your certs and when they expire. NOTES: 1. You may see your name twice in the "my members" area on the dashboard - to see the certs you MUST select the profile that has the HCR number under it. 2.
